How you verify your identity in mySRA will change on 18 August 2025.

Verifying your mySRA account - until 18 August 2025

To keep your mySRA account secure, we ask you to verify your identity each time you log in. This is done by sending a code to your phone by text message or voice call.

Here is what you need to do:

- Register a phone number to receive this code. We recommend using a personal mobile number.
- Have this phone with you whenever you log in as this extra step is required every time. There is no option to turn it off or to 'remember' your device.

Changes to verifying your mySRA account - after 18 August 2025

We're further improving the security of mySRA by switching to app-based verification. Instead of receiving a code by text message, you'll use an authentication app to generate the code.

Here is what you need to do before 18 August:

- Download an authentication app on your smart phone or tablet we recommend using either the Microsoft Authenticator or Google Authenticator. Or you can use another authenticator app if you prefer.
- You only need to do this once unless you change your device.

To install on your Apple device

To install on your Android device

How you will log in with an authenticator app (after 18 August)

- Step 1 Log in to mySRA
 Enter your username and password.
- Step 2 Scan the QR code
 Using your authenticator app, scan the QR code to enrol your device and generate your six-digit code. Press continue.
- Step 3 Enter the code
 Enter the six-digit code shown in your authentication app and complete your login.

What to do if you do not have a smart phone/tablet or cannot download an app
